Are you interested in becoming a qualified sports coach, physical activity instructor, referee or qualified first aider? Do you want to improve on your sporting skills? If so, The Access to Sports Project is running a comprehensive coach education and leadership programme between September 2009 and March 2010. There are a wide range of courses on offer including beginner to advanced level qualifications / awards. These courses will provide participants with the opportunity to obtain nationally recognized, accredited sports coaching and physical instructor qualifications within the sport and leisure industry.
